Dear First Presbyterian family,

In about two months I'll be embarking on a Celtic history and spirituality pilgrimage in Ireland and Iona in Scotland. For eight days of the journey, we will be guided by Rev. Dr. John Philip Newell, a Celtic prophet. In Sacred Earth Sacred Soul, one of his many books, John Philip Newell describes Celtic spirituality this way, "The Celtic spiritual tradition is one that has long emphasized an awareness of the sacred essence of all things. This tradition is in fact part of our Western Christian inheritance, although it has been largely forgotten and at times suppressed. It is a way of seeing, a path of awareness, that can be traced through the centuries, forever unfolding, evolving, emerging again and again to serve a consciousness of the sacred at the heart of all life."

The Celts are first referred to historically around 500 BCE. Today we primarily think of Ireland, Scotland, Wales and Cornwall as Celtic territory, but in 500 BCE that was only the fringe. The Celts spanned the whole of middle Europe, ranging from what is now Turkey at the eastern edge right through to the Atlantic coastline of present-day Spain.

Between now and mid-April, from time to time, I will share what I am learning both here, in Steeple Views, and in worship. My hope is that you can be part of the preparation and part of my journey.
