Pastor's Corner Elder Billy Kirby

Greetings and Happy New Year!

Sunday, I did a "Minute For Mission", at the start of the service, and attempted to provide some detail concerning our financial position through year-end. For those of you who missed it and are imagining a boring snooze-fest of numbers and terms like "contribution income" you would only be partially correct. We laughed, we cried, we did some long division.

In all seriousness, I threw a lot of figures at everyone and I thought it might be a good idea to include a recap in SteepleViews. We came to the congregation at the start of 2023 in an attempt to be completely transparent with where we stood in terms of the budget and the long (maybe shorter than we thought) term impact that would have on the endowment as well as the continued viability of the Church.

The pledge total for 2023 was \$176,970. Budgeted expenses exceeded \$400,000. In other words, we anticipated balancing our 2023 budget with roughly \$240,000 from our endowment. That was, and is, not sustainable. As I said Sunday, it has been my experience that type of news cuts one of two ways... either people lose hope because they fear the goal is unattainable or they double-down, re-engage, become closer as a congregation, and do the hard work. Fortunately, although not surprisingly, this wonderful group did the latter.

As I stated above, the pledge total for 2023 was \$176,970. Actual pledges collected were \$267,285. Yay God!!! Instead of the \$240,000 we anticipated

taking from the endowment we took less than \$125,000. The stock market was also kind to us. I do not think I'm alone in thinking that perhaps more important than an improved financial position was the commitment from each of you. I hope everyone felt, as I did, a growing sense of hope and a renewed feeling of family in 2023.

Now, so as to prevent everyone from thinking we have left all of our financial woes in the rearview mirror, I would add that expenses were greater than anticipated. Expenses go one way... up. We are currently wrapping up the 2024 budget and will report back to you soon. As of today, pledges have exceeded those pledged at the outset of 2023 (yay) but not the actual 2023 pledges (less yay) collected. Please feel free to reach out to me if you have any questions.
