Several Sundays ago Billy Kirby shared numbers relating to the current financial status of FPC. Let's talk numbers related to the Community Breakfast held last Saturday. First of all, it was 20 degrees outside on Saturday. We did have heat in the Fellowship Hall thanks to Rita for calling

HVAC contractor to alert them that we had an event scheduled for that day. We had 27 volunteers, 18 church members and 9 friends and family, come out early on a cold, windy Saturday morning to prepare and serve breakfast. Wow! We filled 148 plates with about 70 guests eating in house. In order to serve that number of plates, we cooked over 300 eggs, 11 boxes of sausage (330 patties), 20 cans of biscuits, 2 gallons of sausage gravy, pancakes (too many to count), and fresh fruit. All the eggs were donated by Kathy Washburn of Ridgeway and Tonya Martin of Ponderosa Farm in Snow Creek.

Thank you to everyone who braved the weather and cooked, set-up, prepared fruit and to-go items, served food and drinks, entertained with music, and cleaned up. We greeted our guests with a smile and provided a warm environment for a hot breakfast to be enjoyed by all.
