

### Pastor's Corner Pastor Bea Miller

Dear First Presbyterian family,

When there is a difference between where we want to be and where we are, we say that there is a Gap. And when we look honestly at the Gap with a clear purpose to guide us, we generate new energy and excitement for what is ahead of us.

We remember from our budget discussions that our first important Gap is financial. Our current annual budget includes the use of \$237,670.72 of our Endowment funds. If we continue to use this much of the Endowment annually, we will exhaust the Endowment in less than 10 years. To close our financial Gap we need to generate enough income to sustain our budget without using Endowment funds. The Think Tank has been looking honestly at this Gap.

With much prayerful discernment, the Think Tank has been considering ways to repurpose our building. The intention is for the repurposing of the building to be revenue generating, with the hope that the revenue will be enough to sustain our budget without the need of Endowment funds.

One of the first suggestions I heard about the future of the building, was to "moth ball" parts of the building that are not being used. The hope with "moth balling" is to reduce the amount of money needed to maintain the building. But the Think Tank has been focused on ways to bring new life to the building, to allow the facility to benefit the community and support our mission and ministry. This building is a gift from previous generations and our hope is that this beautiful expansive facility will support our community and bring glory to God.

Until we toured the whole facility, many on the Think Tank had forgotten how large our building is. Try to remember:

<u>The Main hall off the sanctuary</u>: Kitchenette, Youth Room, Parlor, Bell Choir, Children's Chapel, Library, hall bathrooms.

<u>Turning and continuing down the hall to the Chapel</u>: Choir, Children's Music, Robes, Music Library, Archive, three office spaces, the Chapel.

<u>Behind the stage</u>: two large rooms (previous 4 year old rooms), previous science room, previous 1 year old room, speech therapy room, scout room, hall bathrooms

<u>Under Sanctuary</u>: Nursery and new Weekday School rooms, hall bathrooms <u>Under Offices</u>: Fellowship Hall, Storage room, Elevator, Kitchen, Pantry, Janitor Closet, two Weekday School rooms, Supply Room, hall bathrooms <u>Office area</u>: Elevator, Office Manager, Finance Office with copier room and storage, Irby Class, Session room, Spencer's office, Conference Room, Pastor's office, hall bathrooms

We have been blessed with much space to care for and to use for the benefit of our community and our ministry. And while we will always be able to worship and operate fully as First Presbyterian Church, it is time to share some of our space.

Please plan on attending the Think Tank Update on August 6<sup>th</sup> immediately following worship. During this update, the Think Tank will present their ideas for repurposing our wonderful facility. We have an exciting future ahead of us.
