Dear First Presbyterian family,

Our Presbyterian forbearers were instrumental in the establishment of the United States of America. Most signers of the Declaration of Independence were Presbyterian and Presbyterians helped write the Constitution. Our Presbyterian form of government is reflected in the American structure of local, state, and national governments; not to mention the system of checks and balances, and the establishment of a judicial wing. Gotta love the Presbyterian Book of Order.

Who we are as Presbyterian is part of the fabric and establishment of our nation. I remember a seminary professor talking about the connection between denominations lead by bishops and nations lead by kings, verses representative democracies for both church and nation. He said that when your religious life is structured as a representative democracy it is difficult to live in a world governed by a king. He sighted this as one of the reasons for the American Revolution. Our representative democracy and Book of Order are as important to being Presbyterian as the representative democracy and the constitution are to being American. We even call the Book of Order and Book of Confessions our constitution.
