Dear First Presbyterian family,

You may remember that Billy Kirby, chair of the Administration Team, promised to do a Minute for Mission anytime we draw money from the Endowment. We can expect to hear from Billy soon. When the budget was presented, we noted that .57 cents of every dollar comes from the Endowment. As we are now halfway through the year, a withdrawal from the Endowment is inline with expectations.

I'd like to thank you for your pledged contributions to our mission and ministry. We have received 80% of our pledges!!! Given that it is just the beginning of June, our pledged income is outstanding. Thank you. And if you would be willing to prayerfully consider increasing your pledge, thank you.

However, our expenses are almost equal to our income. Using year-to-date numbers, our income is \$171,748.00, and our expenses are \$167,675.30, as of the third week of May. The bulk of our expenses are salaries, facilities, and operating expenses. None of these expenses are out of the ordinary. And while we talked about planned roof maintenance, those expenses have not yet occurred.

We give thanks to God for our Endowment and all who contributed! Because of the Endowment we have the opportunity to pray, discern and dream with God as we seek God's way forward. Our Think Tank views these issues as adaptive challenges and we are adapting. Please be in prayer for our Think Tank, that they may help us discern God's future for First Presbyterian.
