Minute for Mission: Update on Church Budget Provided by Billy Kirby

As part of our ongoing efforts to keep the congregation up to date on the Church's financial picture I thought I'd share some highlights of the recently adopted budget.

As with any budget, the Church has both income and expenses and those are outlined below.

Total expenses are anticipated to increase more than \$100,000 over last years "actual" expenses as our costs have increased across the board. So, total expenses are budgeted at **\$501,156**.

Our income, as it stands now, is comprised of three main components:

- 1. Contribution income pledges and offerings
- 2. Misc. income i.e., ERTC money (explained below)
- 3. Endowment income money we take to balance the budget

Total income for 2024 is anticipated to be \$501,156 (to make the budget balance).

Contribution (pledges & offerings) income of \$231,945

Miscellaneous income of \$108,625 of which almost \$105,000 of that is the ERTC money we should receive this year. This is money the government is giving us for keeping our staff employed during the pandemic. That is great, however, I caution you that it is non-recurring.

That leaves the money we need to take from the endowment in order to balance the budget. We anticipate taking **\$160,586**. You may recall, that number was predicted to be significantly higher last year. Luckily, we didn't have to take as much as anticipated last year due to the extremely generous giving you folks did; And, endowment has continued to perform well thus far this year so that is good news.

There are some positive trends and good things continue to move forward that could be significant. Keep up the good work.
