Think Tank Progress Report

The Think Tank was formed two years ago and tasked with helping

underutilized portions of our building develop in ways that glorify God. The current space under consideration is now being called the West Wing. It is the western portion of the building beginning at the hall across from the entrance to the Chapel, continuing around the corner were the library was located, and then down the hall to the Youth Room and Parlor. There will be a fire wall/door that separates the Youth Room (new Bell Room) and Parlor from the West Wing. The West Wing also includes the area behind the stage on the lower level. There will be another fire wall/door in the hall between the stage and the bathrooms, again separating the West Wing. The bathrooms close to the stage will no longer be available to the church and WDS. Those bathrooms will be renovated as part of the West Wing. There will also be a fire wall/door separating the West Wing in the wide hall outside the Fellowship Hall, blocking the steps and entrance to the parking lot at the end of the hall.

Those who rent portions of the West Wing will be approved by the Session and will serve functions in the community that further the church's mission and ministry.

In a continued effort to repurpose the vacant space in the church's West Wing, so that the space will be used to further the church's mission and also serve the community, the Think Tank Committee recommended the following two actions to the Session, both of which were approved at the Session meeting on April 28, 2025.

1. The West Wing space will be rented to entities that meet the approval of the Session, such as non-profit organizations; professionals such as counselors, etc.

2. In order to repurpose the West Wing, the church must be rezoned from R-N (neighborhood residential) to R-T (residential transitional). The church will be taxed only on the West Wing. The Session approved the West Wing rezoning.

The rezoning calendar process will be as follows:

• May 6 – The zoning application is submitted to the Martinsville City Zoning Administrator.

- May 21 The Martinsville Planning Commission sets a public hearing date.
- May 23 Notices are sent to nearby property owners, and signs are posted.
- June 18 The Planning Commission hearing takes place.
- July 10 Martinsville City Council approves the rezoning. The rezoning becomes effective 10 days after approval.
