New Food Items for Grace Network

For the quarter April through June, 2017, Grace Network is asking our congregation to supply **canned meats and 4-pound bags of sugar**. There are also optional hygiene items that are always needed, including 4-roll packs of toilet paper and deodorant.



From Grace Network Executive Director Tracy Hinchcliff:



Grace Network has been blessed to have First Presbyterian Church as a food partner since its inception in 2006. There are currently 72 church food partners of Grace Network and every three months (quarterly), food assignments are rotated among the churches to give a financial variety to the churches. Some items are more expensive than other items, so it balances out if the items are rotated. Furthermore, the

last two years, Grace was the recipient of the Christmas Food boxes from Food Lion which contains spaghetti and sauce. With that donation, Grace had an abundance of those items. So, moving forward, Grace is asking FPC to join the other churches in the rotation so your efforts can better be utilized to help Grace have a well-balanced pantry. Grace Network serves approximately 275 families each month and because the mission of Grace is to help people get through a crisis, each family that qualifies for food gets 2½ weeks of groceries. To make sure that we not only have enough food, but the right assortment, it's important that each church is committed to their assigned item. Without your

effort, generosity and commitment, Grace could not do what we do to help those in our community. On behalf of the Grace Network board, staff and clients, we thank you for your donations.
