

Come join us! We will be gathering with several other churches of varying denominations and cultural backgrounds for a unifying service at the Lord's Table to celebrate World Communion Sunday. An ecumenical communion service will be held in the banquet hall at NCI's Building on Baldwin, 191 Fayette St. (parking entrance on Moss St.). The special guest preacher will be Rev. Sharon Risher, a friend of Pastor Mark's at Austin Seminary. Rev. Risher was personally affected by the Charleston, SC, shooting at the Mother Emanuel African Methodist Episcopal Church on June 17, 2015. Her mother—the church's sexton—Ethel Lee Lance, was killed along with eight others, including two cousins and a childhood friend. Rev. Risher has a powerful witness of relying on her faith to get her through that horrific tragedy and how gathering at the Lord's Table can be the unifying element in the turbulent times of today. Please plan to attend this special service to act truly as the body of Christ in the future of our world.

There will be no services or other activities at the FPC building on October 1 so that all may participate in this community event.
