

What is stewardship?

In the church, when someone talks about "stewardship," they usually mean giving money toward the budget. But a look at the dictionary reveals something different: "the conducting, supervising, or managing of something; especially: the careful and responsible management of something entrusted to one's care" (Merriam-Webster). Wikipedia puts it this way: "Stewardship is an ethic that embodies the responsible planning and management of resources" (italics added).



Stewards (or "managers," depending on the translation) are often mentioned in the Bible and featured in some of Jesus' parables (e.g., Luke 12 and 16). Wealthy people depended on stewards to manage their large households or administer scattered agricultural lands faithfully. In the same

way, God, the creator and true owner of the universe and everything in it, including ourselves, expects us to be faithful stewards of all that is in our charge. How does this affect the decisions we make in our daily lives?

Fall is Stewardship Season in our congregation, and the Pony Express bags should be going from house to house in each neighborhood. When you get one, please follow the instructions and pass it on the next person within 48 hours. We are "stewards of God's grace" (1 Peter 4:10), and our response to this campaign will enable our church to carry out God's work in our community for another year. And as we go through the coming year, let's strive to be good stewards of both our personal and our church's resources.
