Prayer Shawl Ministry Needs New People


We are running out of prayer shawls! That's a good problem because it means

Pastor's Corner

Sorry I Don't Have Time

Very early in the morning, while it was still dark, Jesus got up, left the house and went off to a solitary place, where he prayed. Mark 1:35

My child arrived just the other day
He came to the world in the usual way
But there were planes to catch,
and bills to pay
He learned to walk while I was away
And he was talking before I knew it
and as he grew
He said, "I'm gonna be like you, Dad,
You know I'm gonna be like you"

Back in the late 1970s, song writer and singer Harry Chapin wrote a song called "The Cat's In The Cradle," which told of a young boy's desperate attempt to gain a little of his father's attention and time. While the song alludes to the father's love for his son, his time is spent more on providing a living for the household and little time to be with the family.

Missed opportunities abounded for the father to be a "Dad" until the little boy grows into a man. The father, now retired

and feeling alone, calls the son on the phone attempting to gain a little of the son's time, which results in the same excuses he gave in the earlier years. "I'd love to, Dad, if I could find the time, you see, my new job's a hassle, and the kid's got the flu but it's sure nice talking to you, Dad..." The song ends by saying, "...as I hung up the phone, it occurred to me, he'd grown up just like me. My boy was just like me!"

Every time I hear that song I start wondering if God must feel that way about us sometimes. God wants to spend time with us to form that close bond. God wants to hear about our day, our struggles and our joys, but are we too busy to pray? This Thanksgiving, take time to have that conversation with God as Jesus did in prayer. Give thanks, share your heart, ask for direction, and seek out that connection of time with God! Because after all, we have time if we take the time!
