Trustees exercise responsibility "to receive, hold, encumber, manage, and transfer property, real or personal, for the congregation." (Book of Order G-4.0101) We are seeking two persons to serve a full three-year term (class of 2021). The year of the term runs from January to December.

All members of the congregation are invited to submit suggestions to the Nomination Committee for the slate of ruling elders and trustees. All active members of First Presbyterian Church are eligible to hold office.
