John and Vera Jane Kuhn Scholarship Application

The Session of the First Presbyterian Church of Martinsville Virginia has established the John and Vera Jane Kuhn Scholarship Fund for the purpose of providing financial assistance to students seeking undergraduate education or vocational training. John and Vera Jane Kuhn are active members of First Presbyterian Church.

A One thousand dollar (\$1000.) scholarship will be awarded each year from the John and Vera Jane Kuhn Scholarship Fund. The scholarship will be paid directly to the institution of higher learning that the recipient is attending. Funds will be disbursed no later than July 1 of each year, and the scholarship will be applied to tuition costs for undergraduate education or vocational training. A recipient may reapply for the scholarship in subsequent years. Financial need of the applicant will be given primary consideration.

Requirements:

1. The applicant must be a member of First Presbyterian Church of Martinsville, Virginia.
2. The applicant should be active in the life of the church including the youth program.
3. The applicant should be involved in some school and community activities.
4. The applicant should be a good student and demonstrate Christian character.
5. The applicant must be enrolled in an undergraduate or vocational institution in the same year the scholarship is awarded.
6. The applicant must supply the scholarship committee with two letters of character reference from people not related to the applicant.

The Kuhn Scholarship is administrated by a scholarship committee that reviews all applications. Applications for the scholarship will be available March 1 of each year, and the scholarship committee shall award the scholarship by June 1 for the school year beginning in the fall of the same year. Applications are due by April 15.

The Kuhn Scholarship does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, age, sex, national origin, or physical handicap in its selection process. All applications shall be kept in complete confidence and used only for the purpose of this scholarship fund.
