

## Pastor's Corner Pastor Bea Miller

Dear First Presbyterian family,

On Sunday I shared some breath prayers and several of you asked for the words I used, so I will share. But first, a little bit about breath prayer.

God's name in Hebrew, YHWH, the first language to call God by name, is not pronounceable ~ there are no vowels. God's name is the very sound of our breath and with each breath ~ from our first breath at birth to our last breath before we enter eternal life ~ we are calling the name of God. Every breath is a prayer.

There are many forms of prayer. One form is breath prayer. With breath prayer, we breathe in as we say, out loud or in our mind, a phrase and then we breathe out with a different phrase.Many people use breath prayers as a way to fall asleep ~ with God. Before I share Sunday's prayers, I'd like to share two classic breath prayers. The first is a variation of the Jesus prayer, "Lord Jesus Christ, Son of God, Have Mercy on me, a sinner." Of course, you can use the whole Jesus prayer, but here is a slightly shortened breath prayer version:

Breathing In ~ Jesus Son of God Breathing Out ~ Have Mercy on me

Other breath prayers use words from scripture. You can use any scripture. Here is a verse that is commonly used as a breath prayer:

Breathing In ~ Be still and know Breathing Out ~ That I am God On Sunday, I reversed the breathing because the purpose was to focus on release. Breathing out is a physical letting goand adding the words helps our whole selves release. But the truth is, you can't get the breathing wrong. Just breathe and pray as God works wonders in you.

Breathing Out  $\sim$  I surrender my resistance Breathing In  $\sim$  I allow what is to be

And

Breathing Out  $\sim$  I was meant to live in peace Breathing In  $\sim$  Jesus is my peace
