Dear First Presbyterian family,

Happy Independence Day!

Our Presbyterian heritage has deep roots in the American Revolution. King George even called the insurrection in the Americas, "That Presbyterian Revolt."

Presbyterian churches provided sanctuary for revolutionaries while housing both meetings and supplies for the resisters. Our American forefathers, many of whom were Presbyterian, modeled the United States government, after the Presbyterian system of checks and balances as a model. And the only clergyperson to sign the Declaration of Independence was the Reverend John Witherspoon, a Presbyterian. (I once served with Witherspoon's in my congregation.)

In May of 1776, the Reverend John Witherspoon ended his sermon with this prayer for the nation:

God grant that in America true religion and civil liberty may be inseparable, and that the unjust attempts to destroy the one, may in the issue tend to the support and establishment of both. Amen.
